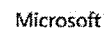

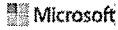

Trojan:Win32/Mustrat.A is a malicious program that is unable to spread of its own accord. It may perform a number of actions of an attacker's choice on an affected computer.

Installation

Trojan:Win32/Mustrat.A copies itself to *c:\documents and settings\administrator\local settings\temp\windows\winsys.exe*.

The malware creates the following files on your PC:

- <current folder>\libcurl-4.dll
- <current folder>\pthreadgc2.dll
- <current folder>\zlib1.dll

Payload

Contacts remote host

Trojan:Win32/Mustrat.A might contact a remote host at *us3.wemineltc.com* using port 3334. Commonly, malware does this to:

- Report a new infection to its author
- Receive configuration or other data
- Download and run files, including updates or other malware
- Receive instructions from a remote hacker
- Upload data taken from your PC

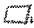
